Duty To God is the first point of the Boy Scout Oath and has always been an important part of the Scouting program. Here is a great opportunity to reinforce these values with your Scouts. This three mile hike will take you to different historic sites, churches and a synagogue in downtown Detroit. You will sing songs and at each stop you will hear stories about that congregation and enjoy a brief talk on one of the **Ten Commandments**. Not only will your Scouts be learning about the Bible, but they will also be learning about many **different faiths**, an important lesson in today's troubled world.

Advancement Opportunities will be available at all levels of Scouting. For **Tiger Cub Scouts**, Walk With God satisfies Advancements 1g and can be the Character Connection for 5f. It can also be used for Electives 6, 8, and 48. For **Wolf Cub Scouts**, Walk With God can form the central activity around which to do achievements 10c and 11. For **Bear Cub Scouts**, Walk With God can provide the focus for achievements 1, 3d, 8e, 12b, and 12d. **Webelos Cub Scouts** can use Walk With God to provide the occasion around which they build requirement 8 for their Webelos rank advancement. They can also use it for their Traveler activity badge. As with almost all cub Scout advancements, Walk With God will be an event in which the entire family can participate.

Walk With God is also being designed to promote a Scouts progress towards earning the age appropriate religious emblem of their faith. For Webelos Scouts, the religious emblem can be applied for advancement purposes for the Webelos Badge. It can also be applied for advancement purposes for Venturers seeking their Venturing Bronze (Ministering) or Venturing Gold Award (Social).

Schedule: The day will begin with check-in at 8:00 a.m. at the park pavilion. The hike will conclude by 3:00 p.m. back at the check-in location. Scouts, parents and leaders should wear proper walking shoes and bring a water bottle or canteen. **Lunch is included** with the hike. Every participant will receive a special commemorative patch.
